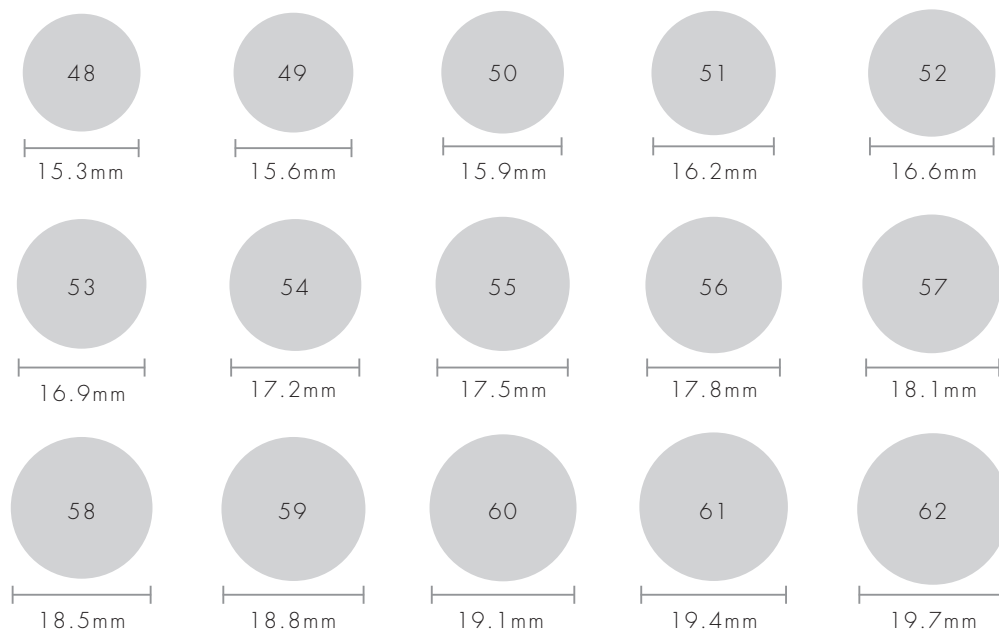
SIZE GUIDE

RINGS

To determine a ring size, please print this 1:1 sizing guide. Use an existing ring of perfect fit and place it on one of the grey circles. Make sure the entire grey area is aligned with the inner edge of the ring to determine the exact circumference. Should your ring fit between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size.

Based on the metric system, the circumference of your ring determines the European sizing. The diameter of the circle matching your ring is marked below the grey circle. Always measure a ring size with hands of normal body temperature. Cold fingers are smaller, and warm fingers are slightly larger.

The ring size required may depend on the type of design and how the ring is adjusted on the finger. For a wider ring or several rings stacked on the same finger, we recommend ordering one size larger than you would choose for a narrow ring.
